

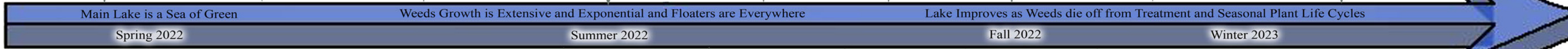

 ODNr solution is to Harvest the Weeds
No Simple Research Performed - Harvesting Spreads Milfoil


 Harvesting is Slow and can't keep up with weed growth


Aqua Doc Offers No Long Term Solution - Continues to Spray at the Expense of Property Owners


 Beaches are nearly unuseable due to the Weeds and/or Goose Droppings
ODNR doesn't seem to care that beaches are Not Sanitary and ignore fact that Goose Droppings Contribute to Blue Green Algae Blooms


 Dr Jones to conduct study and asks "How was this lake allowed to get this bad"


 ODNr Shifts Course and Treats 500+ Acres - Treatment are Successful


ODNR Ignores Recommendation from Experts at SePRO and Aquatic Controls for More Treatment this Season


ODNR agrees to treat 1200 acres of Milfoil, Experts Recommend Treating all 1900 to prevent reinfection of treated areas


 ODNr Renews Aqua Docs Contract. **Aquatic Controls Not even considered or given a chance to Quote the Job.**

Advocacy Group is formed and begins Searching for Solutions


Advocacy Contacts SePRO and introduces Dr Jones to WaterShed and the ODNr



Advocacy Pleads for ODNr to Listen to the Experts at SePro and Aquatic Controls to Shift Course and look into Treating the Lake


Advocacy Group Brings SePro to the Lake and SePro Proposes a Solution



SePRO and Aquatic Controls Recommends Treating More This Season




Advocacy Group Visits Aquatic Controls and Learns about the Importance of Proper Dosing and Spraying Equipment, Aquatic Controls recommends treating all 1900 Acres of Milfoil



Advocacy Group tries to push ODNr to use Aquatic Controls for 2023 Season for Lake Treatment

 ODNr plans to aggressively begin treatment of the lake as early as possible


 ODNr plans to **only treat 1200 Acres** of Milfoil.


 ODNr plans to have 75% of lake open by July 4th.

Advocacy Group is in alignment with treating the lake as early as possible, but not in line with the Applicator Aqua Doc





Advocacy Group and Experts say treat all 1900 as early as possible to prevent re-infection of treated areas and decrease risk of algae blooms





Advocacy Group is pushing for 75% of lake to be open by Memorial Day
